# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## DEPARTURE DAYS

Most hotels request arrival on Saturdays during peak season. However the following properties have alternative arrival days:- Resort Hotel Arrival Bormio Villarina Flexible Tonale Angelo Sunday Mt. Tremblant Various Flexible During low season most of our properties will allow arrival on various days.

## FERRIES

We use the short sea crossings operated by P & O and DFDS ferries from Dover to Calais and Dunkirk. Outside peak season we can also offer Euro-tunnel with the appropriate supplement. We do, however, strongly recommend that groups travelling from the North or any long distance from Dover choose the ferry option to allow a break from their coach journey.

## COACH TOURS

All coach tours are fully bonded through ABTA. See our booking conditions for full details. Our coach tours will be operated by our partners SKILLS COACHES OF NOTTINGHAM who have a large, superb fleet of very high standard and modern touring coaches. Our single decker vehicles range from 49 to 61 seats with ample luggage space and all facilities that you would expect from a continental touring coach. All vehicles will be equipped with DVD, toilet, partly reclining seats, drinks facilities and seat belts.

## AIR TOURS

All air tours are financially protected by the Civil Aviation Authority (ATOL). See our booking conditions for full details. Most of our tours are suitable for travel by air. For European resorts we will use a number of short haul carriers to include Flybe, Ryanair, Easyjet and Alitalia. This will enable us to locate a suitable route for your group both from the UK and destination airport. For Canada we will be using Air Canada and British Airways to Montreal for Mt. Tremblant. Full details of flights will be given to groups as soon as possible after booking. A few examples of routes are outlined below:-

### SMALL GROUPS

All coach quotations will be based on 40 paying passengers with 5 free places. Air tours are costed on 30 paying passengers + 3 free places.

We are fully aware that in the present economic downturn many school's will struggle to recruit sufficient numbers to fill a coach on their own. Ski and Sport will treat all groups the same, irrespective of size. We are happy to combine smaller groups on coaches to ensure the tour goes ahead as planned and at the price quoted. We will endeavour to do our utmost to keep any travel variations to a minimum.

Alternatively we are happy to base any quotation on lower numbers either by coach or by air. Should a group of less than 40 paying passengers travelling by coach elect to travel on their own they will be asked to pay the appropriate supplement of £4 per person below 40. Some examples are shown below:-

No of paying passengers	Amount of supplement
37	= £12.00 per person (ie 37 x £12 = £444.00 total)
35	= £20.00 per person (ie 35 x £20 = £700.00 total)

### SNOW GUARANTEE

Resorts have been chosen carefully for their snow record and it is very rare to find little or no snow in the resorts we feature. The following table gives an idea of some of these resorts and their snow record. All of our resorts also have a high percentage of snow cannons covering runs eg. Folgarida with 92% coverage.

This will obviously supplement the natural coverage Ski and Sport will ensure that all groups will ski as booked and in the unlikely event of having no snow in the resort of their choice they will be transported free of charge (or moved to) the nearest "open resort" with adequate snow and provided with a lift pass for that resort. If there is no snow in any resort in the immediate area accessible by transport, then a refund per day will be given via the insurance cover for missed skiing.

\* Groups have the option of taking their own insurance at the appropriate reduction.

\*\* We offer what we feel is the best party leader family concessions on the market: Party leader spouse travels at half price. 2 party leader children (under 17) travel at 50% These are subject to a minimum group size of 40 paying passengers. Smaller groups are given a prorata concession and free place ratio if required.

## SKI SCHOOL

We will only be using the local OFFICIAL ski school in each resort. This ensures that all instructors are fully qualified, groups in lessons will have priority on lifts and an official certificate will be given to all pupils at the end of the week. Group sizes will be a maximum of 12 for ski groups and 8 for snowboard groups.

## EQUIPMENT

We will ensure that all equipment is of a high standard, fully serviced and changed regularly. Our representatives will oversee all fittings. In a number of resorts (eg Bormio) equipment is stored in the shop at the end of the day and collected each morning. This alleviates the need to carry equipment long distances.

## INSPECTION VISITS

We are able to arrange Ski Inspection visits for our customers. These are in the format of weekends/long weekends or tagging onto a full group tour. We will provide travel, half board accommodation and lift pass.

Alternatively we are able to offer shorter inspection visits by air to any of our European resorts, tailored to suit your requirements and dates. These will include flights, half board accommodation and lift pass.

All European tours will include A HOT MIDDAY MEAL either back in the hotel at lunchtime or on the mountain at our restaurant (Bormio). We feel that students need as much energy as they can get and therefore a hot lunch is much more beneficial than a packed lunch (provided as a cost cutting option) which is regularly discarded.

Ski and Sport are able to send any group booking with us a detailed powerpoint on any of our resorts prior to booking and to help promote the tour. Posters and savings cards

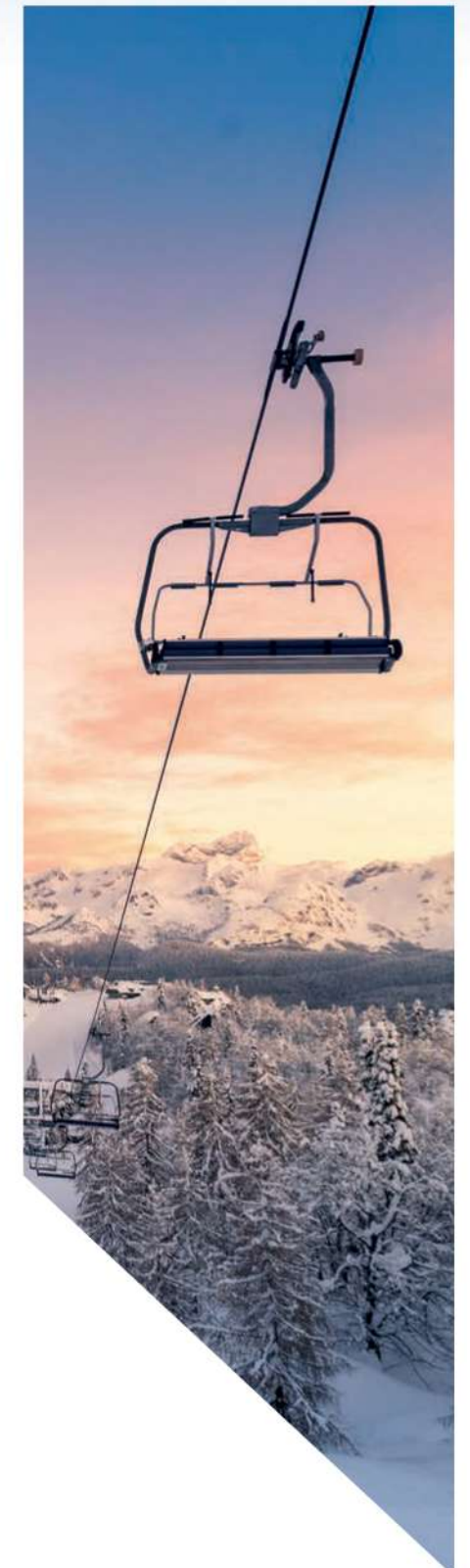

## The showcase of Alpine skiing

Being one of Italy's premier resorts, situated 3 hours north of Milan, Bormio offers a wide range of skiing to suit all abilities including the challenging World Cup Men's downhill which is one of the longest and most difficult runs on the World Cup circuit.

The resort has also housed the Alpine Ski World Championships on a number of occasions and is destined to be part of the Winter Olympic Circuit in a few year's time.

The quaint town of Bormio itself with its cobbled streets and grand stone facades is a safe area to walk around due to the majority of it being pedestrianised. There are numerous local shops as well as restaurants, bars and supermarkets etc.

This high level, snow sure resort, is a good choice for Easter ski tours as the majority of runs are situated above the small hamlet of Bormio 2000, named after its altitude. The season in Bormio runs from late November/early December until late April. The nearby area of Stelvio is also Italy's premier summer ski resort.

Access to the mountain is via a high speed gondola running from the edge of the village to Bormio 2000 taking approximately 8 minutes. From here there is access to the top of the Cima Bianca mountain at 3000m via a series of chairlifts or the large cable car which runs directly to the top.

The nursery slopes are served by two moving carpets at Bormio 2000 adjacent to our ski school and Restaurant/Hotel Cedrone. Beginners soon progress from here to longer runs served by twin drag lifts. All other lifts are chairlifts of varying size serving numerous runs of varying length and difficulty.

Bormio boasts some of the longest runs in the Alps including runs from the top of the mountain at 3012m down to the village itself, a distance of some 7 miles. In total there are over 80km of runs served by an efficient system of 23 lifts, mainly chairlifts. The resort is an intermediate's paradise with a wide selection of long runs on both sides of the mountain either side of the cable car.

The lift pass also covers the nearby resort of Santa Caterina which is a 20 minute bus ride away and the quiet area of Isolaccia also a short distance away.

There are also plans to connect the resorts of Bormio and Santa Caterina in the next couple of years. For the more adventurous the resort's recently added snow park is an attraction for more competent skiers.

### HOTEL NAZIONALE

☆☆☆ 140 Beds

The 3 star 120 bed Hotel Nazionale is situated adjacent to the town centre with its shops, bars and café's and only a short walk across the bridge to the ski slopes and ski hire.

The Hotel has been a popular choice by our groups for over 10 years due to its position and its friendly atmosphere together with its many facilities. Again all rooms have private bathrooms and TV. The hotel has an excellent Taverna bar, a swimming pool, fitness room, games area and meeting room.

Breakfast and evening meal are again taken in the hotel's spacious dining room with excellent, plentiful food and the midday meal on the mountain.



### HOTEL VILLARINA

☆☆☆ 85 Beds

This lovely 3 star hotel is family owned and run and has offered a very warm welcome to our groups for over 20 years. Situated at the entrance to the town and an easy walk to slopes and the town itself, the recently renovated hotel offers approximately 85 beds in rooms and apartments of 2 to 6 beds.

All rooms are pleasantly furnished with en-suite facilities. There is a lounge/tv room, games room and an excellent basement taverna bar that is for the exclusive use of groups.

Breakfast and evening meals are taken in the hotel's own dining room with a hot midday meal at the Restaurant Cedrone at Bormio 2000.

# BORMIO

## HOTEL CAPITANI

☆☆☆☆

This excellent, smaller hotel of 60 beds is owned by the Capitani family who also own and run the Hotel Nazionale and Hotel Derby in Bormio. We have used the hotel for 5 years and all groups have requested to return.

With panoramic mountain views and a TV, rooms are tastefully decorated with light wood furniture and light colours and are equipped with a private bathroom, with shower, as well as safe, flat screen tv and hairdryer. Free Wi-Fi access is available in the lobby.

The Capitani's own restaurant serves a variety of local dishes, specialty pastas and an excellent buffet breakfast. The hotel also has a bar and sitting area and is conveniently situated on the edge of the town and close to the slopes.



## HOTEL NEVADA

☆☆☆

Undoubtedly the best positioned hotel in Bormio adjacent to the main gondola at the foot of the slopes and only a short walk into the town. This 3 star hotel has 85 beds in high standard rooms of mainly 2 to 4 beds each with television, a minibar, safe and a number with balconies looking out onto the slopes.

All meals are taken in the Hotel's own restaurant and food is of a very high standard with lots of menu choices. On the ground floor is a large and very popular bar where groups can play games or watch tv, together with an intimate sitting room with open fire.

Downstairs is a fitness suite and sauna, very popular with our adults. The terrace is a natural solarium where you can relax and take in the splendid views as well as enjoy a snack.



## HOTEL DERBY

☆☆☆

We are pleased to offer (mainly for adult groups) the excellent 3 star + Hotel Derby, also situated in an enviable position at the foot of the Stelvio run, adjacent to our ski/boot hire shop and only a short walk into town.

Also owned by the Capitani family, this high standard Alpine-style hotel features a large dining room serving a buffet style breakfast, with a choice of cold meats, cheeses and freshly baked bread. Other meals are also of a high standard and specialising in local dishes and produce.

All carpeted rooms in the Derby feature full bathroom facilities, flat screen satellite tv, hairdryer and a balcony. The hotel also boasts its own swimming pool and wellness centre.



## HOTEL SANT ANTON

☆☆☆☆

The excellent 4 star Hotel Sant Anton is situated in Bormio itself, close to the town centre, shops, Thermal swimming baths and an easy walk to the ski slopes and ski hire. The hotel has around 130 beds housed in spacious, brightly decorated rooms of 2 to 4 beds, all have full bathrooms with hydro massage showers, Satellite TV, telephone, hair dryer, safe and small fridge.

Breakfast and evening meals are taken in the hotel's dining room with lunch on the mountain. Food is of a high standard, as you would expect from a 4 star hotel, including an excellent breakfast buffet and a large choice of hors d'oeuvre, vegetables and several Italian and international dishes in the evening.

In addition the hotel has an excellent Wellness/Fitness Centre, a heated boot room, a bar and lounge area. If skiers don't want to walk to the lifts the Hotel runs a shuttle service.



## MEALS

With the exception of the Hotel Nevada, all our groups staying in Bormio take their midday meal on the mountain at the Restaurant Cedrone, adjacent to the nursery slopes, where they are served hot food each day and including superb local pizzas cooked in the restaurant's separate pizza hut.

The Cedrone has an excellent terrace which is a sun trap where the food is served by waiters. Groups staying in the Hotel Nevada go back to the hotel at lunch time for a hot midday meal.

## SKI EQUIPMENT

For many years we have used the excellent services of Celsino Sports (Celso's) where skiers are fitted out with a high standard of equipment. The main shop is situated at the foot of the slopes and groups leave this equipment at the shop each evening to collect the next day. They can therefore walk to and from their hotel in normal winter footwear. There is very little carrying of gear.

Again clients of the Hotel Nevada store their equipment under the hotel as it is adjacent to the gondola. Celso Sports also has a shop at Bormio 2000 and an arrangement for some groups to store equipment there.

## LESSONS

Again Ski and Sport have an excellent relationship with one of the main official ski schools in Bormio itself where they have an office as well as one at Bormio 2000.

They offer a high standard of instruction with many of their instructors having worked there for over 15 years. The standard of English is also very good and all instructors are first aid trained as well as being in radio contact.

## APRÈS SKI

Without the need to travel away from the resort, Bormio is fortunate to be able to offer a wide choice of apres ski activities all within a short walk of our hotels. The superb, recently expanded Thermal Baths, Wellness Centre and Beauty Farm with its indoor and outdoor pools, restaurant and bar together with other facilities is a popular choice for all visitors.

There is an indoor Ice Rink, again in the town which is open throughout the winter with skate hire. In addition we can offer tobogganing on the safe floodlit area at the foot of the slopes, floodlit skiing, pizza evenings, disco, lots of shops and disco.

For groups with their own transport it is possible to arrange bowling across in Livigno or down in the area capital of Sondrio.

## *A skiers paradise*

The smaller, also high level, sister resort of Bormio, Santa Caterina has long been a firm favourite for many of our regular ski groups. Situated approximately 14 km from the town of Bormio, Santa Caterina forms part of the Stelvio National Park and is a typical high level alpine village with an enviable snow record. With a top ski height of nearly 3000m and a high level village of 1700m, the resort has a long season running from late November until early May. It is always possible to ski back to the village even during a late Easter. The resort also holds numerous alpine events including regular ladies World Cup races and will also feature in the future Winter Olympics along with nearby Bormio.

The Ski Stadium with very friendly beginners area is located in the village itself and only a short walk from each of our 3 featured hotels. A further beginner area can also be found at the stopping point of the first gondola in a snow sure area at around 2000m. Intermediate and better skiers will use the modernised chairlift system serving the intermediate slopes above the village or travel on the two stage gondola which ascends up the superb fairly recently opened Sunny Valley ski area.

This high level area is an attraction for all skiers as soon as they are able as it is a large open sunny, but snow sure, easy to intermediate area at over 2800m. There are a variety of more challenging, partly tree lined runs back to the village itself. This modern lift system serves some 60km of piste with little or no queuing and the resort's excellent snow record is also supplemented with excellent snow making facilities.

### APRÈS SKI

Skating, disco, shops, swimming (Hotel), pizza, floodlit skiing, bars, café.

### MEALS

All our groups will receive hot lunches every day served at the hotel.

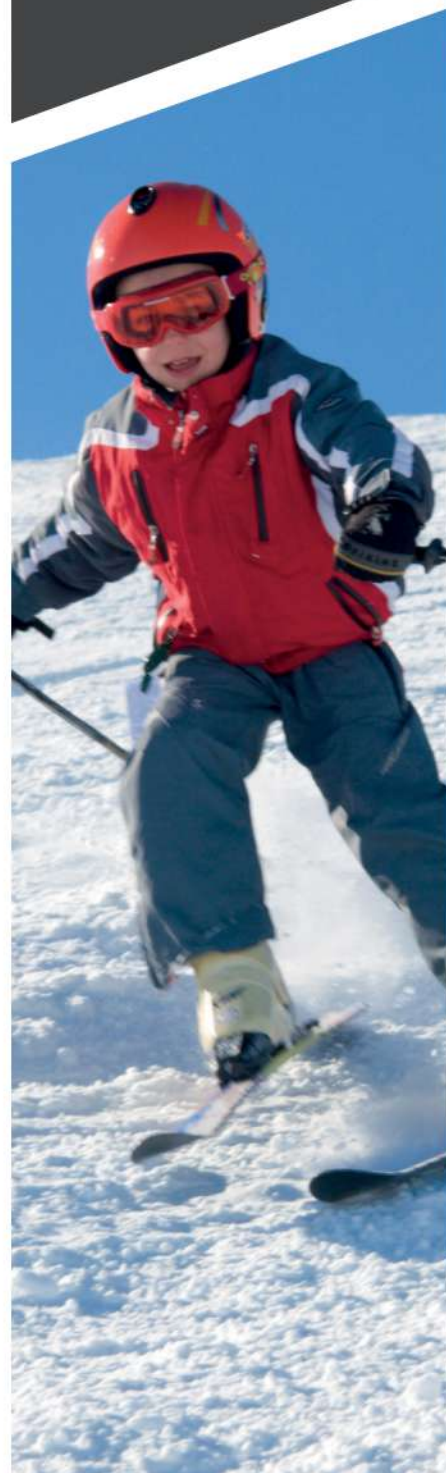

In total some 120km of well groomed pistes are served by 31 lifts on the lift pass with the nearest lift and run being only 100 metres from our hotel.

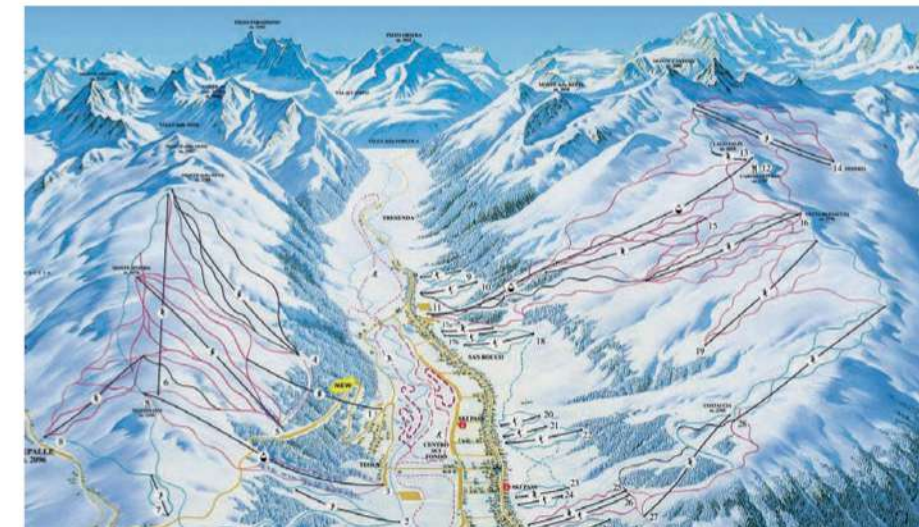

## Amazing views

We have worked in this high level popular Italian resort for many years. This linear style resort is situated in the Val di Sole area above the tree line on the high level pass between the regions of Trentino and Lombardy. Tonale has a village height of 1880m and a top elevation of 3030m, together with a summer ski area on the Presena Glacier ensuring you are able to ski throughout the year.

Passo Tonale and the nearby resort of Ponte di Legno combine to offer superb skiing for all abilities. The long off piste runs from the glacier down to the charming little town of Ponte di Legno offer a challenge for any budding experts and with the gondola link back up to Tonale, added in 2007, it has made it a superb addition to the ski area. In addition the world famous off piste Pisgana slope is one of the most challenging in Europe being some 14km long and dropping 2000m vertically.

Most runs in the area are wide, sunny and above the tree line. Unlike many resorts even the 6 beginner slopes at village level are snow sure throughout the main season. Intermediates are well catered for with some excellent long runs served by high speed quad lifts. Snowboarders are also well catered for with wide open slopes served by numerous high speed chairlifts.

Skiers who are not in lessons can also opt for the Super Skirama Dolomiti Adamello Brenta lift pass which covers nearby resorts such as Madonna di Campiglio, Folgarida/Marilleva, Pejo and Pinzolo, giving a huge 380km of piste and served by a local bus service.

### MEALS

All our hotels offer full board which includes, buffet breakfast, hot midday meal and evening meal.

### SKI EQUIPMENT

Equipment is of a high standard and is taken from our shop opposite the Hotel Adamello. Skis and boots are stored in the hotel's own ski and boot room under the hotel.

## Quality Resort

Folgarida is a firm favourite with many of our regular school groups due to its safe environment and an excellent range of skiing to suit most abilities.

Folgarida and its sister resort Marilleva share their slopes with the nearby larger resort of Madonna di Campiglio which is available (with a supplement) for stronger skiers. The Val di Sole area is renowned for its heavy snowfall that usually guarantees good skiing until late April. Over 90% of the skiing is served by artificial snow making facilities which are used to build a good base in the early season.

Groups regularly praise the easy progression the resort offers, from beginner to intermediate and beyond. With lots of wide tree lined and sheltered slopes there are very few queues on its modern lift system.

There are three areas of linked slopes around Madonna; Pancugolo to the west, Pradalago to the north and Passon Groste (the highest area) to the east. Pradalago is also linked by lifts and runs to Monte Vigo, where the slopes of Folgarida and Marilleva also meet. New lifts have been added in recent years including one to the nearby resort of Pinzolo which has added a further 40km of piste to the circuit.

### MEALS

All our hotels offer full board which includes, buffet breakfast, hot midday meal and evening meal.

### SKI EQUIPMENT

The ski hire shop is located adjacent to the Hotel Annamaria.

### LESSONS

We work with the official Italian Ski school whose base is situated below the Hotel Annamaria.

### APRÈS SKI

Groups take all meals in the hotel as they can ski down to within 100 metres of the accommodation or, take the gondola back to the resort. The food offered consists of a buffet breakfast, a hot midday meal of pasta, pizza and vegetarian options and a good choice of dishes for evening meals.

The hotel also has its own swimming pool, with an attendant, which is available to our groups free of charge, a bar and TV lounge as well as a meeting room and disco area.



### HOTEL UNION

The sister hotel to the Annamaria and run/operated by the same family. It has an enviable position literally adjacent to the gondola linking skiers to the rest of the network. Most skiers can also ski back to the hotel or, if necessary, take the gondola back for midday meal and at the end of the skiing day. This 3 star hotel is situated in the upper hamlet of Folgarida at 1300m. There are 90 rooms of 2, 3 and 4 beds all with en-suite facilities, telephone, safe and hairdryer. ## Skiing Paradise

Cesana Torinese forms part of the huge Milky Way ski area of both Italy and France and encompasses the well known Italian resorts of Sauze d'Oulx, Sestriere and Claviere together with the nearby French resort of Montgenevre. In total the area offers some 400km of varied slopes.

Cesana is a relaxed resort in the heart of this large ski area which has welcomed British skiers for many years. This traditional Italian village boasts an excellent ski season and is in an enviable position to allow exploration of the whole area.

Within a short walk from our hotel there is direct access to some 39 marked pistes for all abilities served by 11 ski lifts and including an excellent snowboard park in Cesana itself. These include 9 easy runs, 6 reds for the more experienced skier and 4 expert runs including the 1km long Kandahar Motta black run. The area has a reliable snow record supplemented by an extensive snowmaking network. Beginners are also well catered for with a delightful sunny area above the village itself and its neighbour Claviere.

## Perfect base to explore

Situated in the Valtellina Province of Northern Italy, this compact ski area was recently introduced into our Italian ski programme. Being only a 10 minute drive from Bormio and 30 minutes from Santa Caterina, groups are able to ski all 3 resorts (if they wish) that are covered on the local lift pass during an action packed week.

Groups will ski the lovely quiet little areas of Cima Piazzi and San Colombano-Isolaccia Oga which is served by 9 lifts including the high speed 8 seater gondola that runs from opposite our hotel and links into the rest of the complex. Skiing ranges from 1340m to a top ski height of 2547m and is ideal for beginners and intermediates due to the variety of slopes and being unbelievably quiet, even during peak season. A very accommodating nursery area is located above the tree line near the top of the mountain and a series of improver runs can be found with sheltered tree lined slopes back to the resort.

After a couple of days in Isolaccia groups can take their instructors with them to ski the resorts of Bormio and/or Santa Caterina. During these days we arrange the instructors to work for 6 hours per day. On the final day before departure groups need to ski Isolaccia once again due to drivers hours.

### MEALS

All our hotels offer full board which includes, buffet breakfast, hot midday meal and evening meal.

The Flying Mozart lift opens the whole of the modern Snow Space ski area, including the G link and also the new connection to Kleinarl.

Wagrain is the most expansive area within the Snow Space region offering long wide pistes from top to bottom. The runs vary around resort in grading allowing many miles to be covered.

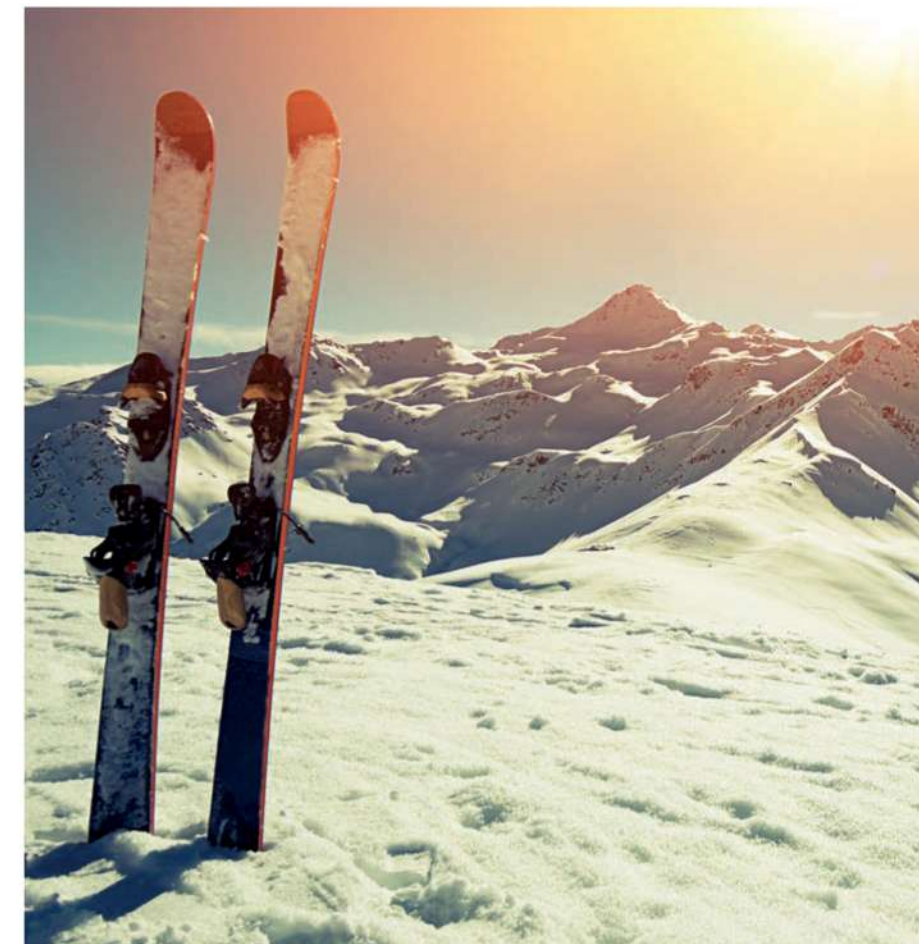

As with the Wagrain area, our experienced Austrian agents will be overseeing the resort and their unrivalled expertise will ensure all groups have a memorable experience. We are sure that groups will wish to return here year after year as they do in Wagrain.

Overall there are 8 separate ski areas in the region. With the normal Ski Lungau pass you have access to 150km of piste with an area extension available to cover Obertauern as well.

The 4 main ski areas are Fanningberg, Grosseck-Speiereck, Katchberg and Obertauern all of which are a short journey from our Hotel.

Fanningberg is only 4km away and is an excellent introduction to your weeks skiing. Here the "Samsonjet", the longest 6 seater chairlift in the world, gives access to a variety of skiing for all abilities on 24km of blue, red and black runs up to an altitude of 2115 metres. With the exception of a short challenging part at the Zirbenjet all the pistes are wonderfully wide and there is a great carving slope and a "FANNI-Kinderpark."

The Grosseck-Speiereck area is again only a short 6km journey away and also includes St Michael and Mauterndorf. Its 50km of excellent slopes include 26km of blue, 17km of red and 7km of black runs up to an altitude of 2400m and served by 16 lifts. Directly in St Michael there is the new 8 person gondola which takes you into the heart of this area and skiers will enjoy the ride back to the valley station from Speiereck to St Michael on a total length of 4.5km and an altitude drop of 1300m.

The most beautiful runs are to be found just below the Speiereck. Here the evenly spaced snow cannons guarantee great conditions right through until spring.

The ski area Katschberg-Aineck Katchberg, with a total of 70km of piste, also offers some diverse and challenging descents. The area is ideal for beginners and early intermediates with the exception of the Direttissima black run which is renowned to be one of the steepest in the Alps. In total the Katchberg area is served by 16 lifts covering 10km of blue, 50km of red and 10km of black runs up to an altitude of 2220m.

The famous, snow sure resort of Obertauern is also available on the area ski pass and is a 20 minute drive away from our hotel. Its superb ski "circuit" covers 100km of pistes served by 26 lifts and again is fantastic for beginners and intermediates and up to an altitude of nearly 2400m.

## MEALS

All our hotels offer full board which includes, buffet breakfast and evening meal. Our groups will have a choice of either, returning to the hotel for a hot lunch, or, having a packed lunch on the mountain.

## SKI EQUIPMENT

The ski hire team will come to the accommodation on arrival day or early morning of day two for ski fit.

The 159 beds are divided into multi bedded rooms for students and 1 and 2 bedded rooms for staff, whose rooms also have a tv and safe. Rooms are comfortably furnished and all with private bathrooms.

The house also has a new 32 x 15 metre multi-sports hall suitable for football, basketball, volleyball, badminton and tennis. In addition, the indoor climbing wall is available for an introduction to climbing, there is a chill lounge, a 50 sq metre glass terrace and a large tent pavilion. Meals are taken in the restaurant with a choice of hot midday meal or taking a packed lunch if groups wish to stay out all day.

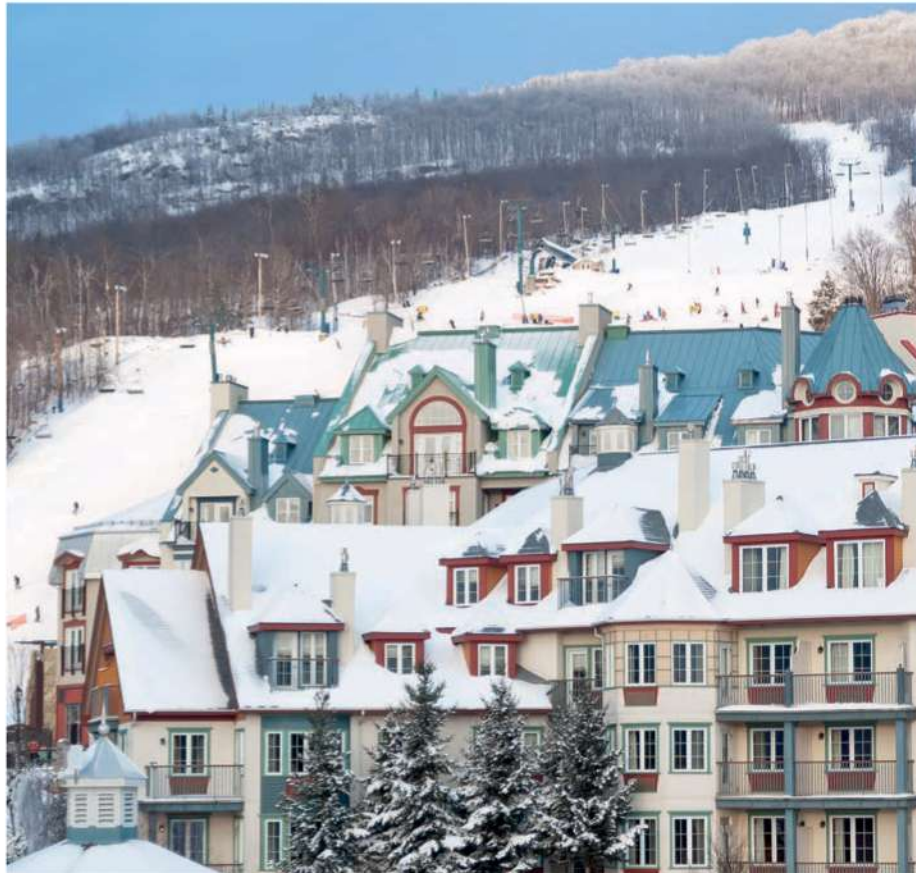

We successfully introduced this region to our ski programme 5 years ago. This area boasts several ski areas but we have carefully chosen 3 areas in the beautiful Western White Mountains to allow you to ski 2 areas in one week. With their 100% snow making facilities and excellent snow record, the areas of Loon Mountain, Cannon Mountain and Waterville Valley provide you with a wonderful experience and great range of skiing. Each tour to this area is tailor made to suit your requirements.

From the Peak of Loon Mountain, a short coach journey from our hotel, there are 60 runs, all carefully designed and maintained. There's top to bottom snow making and a variety of runs for all abilities, including steep moguls and wider cruising trails. Loon's terrain has been carefully developed over the years with expert slopes on North Peak complementing the flattering intermediate pistes that wind their way down through the trees. The East Basin also provides a challenge to more expert skiers. To make the best of your day on the mountain head to the emptier slopes of South Peak connected from the summit by the Tote Road quad or the Lincoln Express quad from its own base. Beginners will quickly progress to the gentle skiing area on Bear Claw or Brookway.



Cannon Mountain offers the remarkable combination of a ruggedly beautiful setting, first class lifts and a relaxed state park environment. # TERMS & CONDITIONS

## 1. YOUR CONTRACT

These bookings conditions and our privacy policy, together with any other written information we brought to your attention before we confirmed your booking, form the basis of your contract with Ski & Sport Ltd, trading as Ski & Sport and/or Ski & Sport Travel ('we' or 'us' or 'our'). The party leader accepts the following terms and conditions on behalf of all party members and will be our sole point of correspondence and contact. Please take the time to read them carefully as they set out and explain the responsibilities and obligations by all parties when booking with us.

The contract between us is governed by the law of England and Wales and any dispute will be dealt with under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales, except if you live in Scotland, when you may choose, with our consent, to have the contract governed by the laws of Scotland, and any dispute dealt with in the Scottish courts.

## 2. BOOKING DETAILS & PAYMENT

A contract will only exist when we have received the required deposit and have acknowledged receipt of your completed form by the issue of our booking confirmation. Upon receipt, if you believe that any details on the confirmation are incorrect you must advise us immediately as changes cannot be made later. We will not be responsible for any loss or agree any compensation if we are not notified of any inaccuracies in any document within seven days of our sending it out. Where a provisional booking is made and a holding deposit is paid to us, the party leader accepts our booking terms and conditions and confirms to the deposit schedules that follow, accepting that full deposits will be due. To take out an option on your chosen tour please contact our offices either by telephone 01246 292010, post or by email [skiandsport@btconnect.com](mailto:skiandsport@btconnect.com). Provisional booking details will then be confirmed to you in writing, a booking form and flight names form (air groups only) sent to you. This option will be held for an agreed period up to 4 weeks in order for you to collect deposits. You are under no obligation during this provisional booking period. To confirm the option a deposit of £150.00 per paying passenger together with the completed booking form, should be returned to us. This deposit is non-refundable, unless under the terms of our insurance cover. A confirmation invoice will then be sent to you. A second deposit of £100.00 per paying passenger for coach tours and £150.00 for air tours will be due 6 weeks after the first deposit and will be invoiced. Final details of your party will be requested approximately 14 weeks before departure. From this information a final invoice will be drawn up and your final balance will be due 12 weeks before departure. The full amount outstanding must be received by us no later than 12 weeks before departure. As well as the cancellation charges detailed below, there will be a £15 per person administration charge if payment is not received by the due date. If the interim and final balances are not paid by the due date, this will be a breach of the contract between us, entitling us to reserve the right to treat this booking as cancelled by you in which case all deposits paid will be forfeited. The booking information that you provide to us may be passed on to the relevant suppliers involved in your travel and services arrangements. This information may therefore be provided to public authorities such as customs and immigration authorities if required by them or as required by law. This may apply to any sensitive information that you give us such as details of any disabilities, or dietary and religious requirements. If we cannot pass this information on to the relevant suppliers it may not be possible for us to provide the service booked. Therefore in making this booking you consent to this information being passed on to the relevant persons. Full details of our data protection policy are available on request.

Any monies paid by customers to party leaders are held by party

leaders solely as agents of the customer until such time as the company has received that money.

We reserve the right to charge a greater first deposit, if this is the case you will be advised at the time of booking. This is necessary due to events such as bookings using low cost/scheduled airlines who require full payment at time of booking.

## 3. CANCELLATION & AMENDMENT

In the event of cancellation by a paying member more than 12 weeks before the course, the deposit (s) may be transferred to a substitute member. However, if this is not possible then the deposit (s) will be retained by us. Any cancellation or amendment request must be sent to us in writing and will not take effect until received by us. The minimum cancellation charge is the deposit (s) paid and/or due by the date of cancellation. Should a transfer request be made within 12 weeks of departure we reserve the right to levy an administration fee of £20 per change, plus any direct costs incurred. Cancellation of a tour or a paying member within a tour will be subject to the following scale of charges:-

If the number of adults in your party accounts for 20% or more of your party or if any cancellation reduces the number of paying members below the minimum number required for a particular tour price or concession (including free places), we reserve the right to re-cost the price of the tour and the invoice will be adjusted accordingly for all remaining group members.

All communications relating to this contract (in particular any requests to cancel or amend your tour arrangements) must be from the Lead Name in writing and in English and delivered by hand, fax email or sent by recorded delivery post.

## 4. HOLIDAY PRICES & GUARANTEE

The lead in prices shown in this brochure are for guidance only and are normally for low season dates. We reserve the right to change any of these prices. Prior to making your reservation you will be given a detailed price breakdown. Prices shown in the brochure are based on exchange rates published on 4th November 2020. The rates were as follows: Euro = 1.109, US\$ = 1.296, Canadian \$ 1.710.

Local Taxes: Please be aware that many European areas (regions and cities) are introducing and altering a Tourist Tax or Resort Fees payable for all visitors. These were originally introduced to improve local tourist infrastructure. In some cases these are payable in resort in local currency to your hotel on arrival but wherever possible we will include them in your tour price. We will advise the situation on booking.

Once the final price of your arrangements has been confirmed, no amendment will be made to it unless it is to make a correction to an error, or if our costs change as a result of an increase or decrease in transportation costs or dues, taxes or fees payable for services such as landing taxes or embarkation or disembarkation fees at ports or airports or as a result of any changes in the exchange rates which have

been used to calculate the cost of your arrangements. Furthermore, surcharges may result due to governmental action, and/or changes in VAT rates on Accommodation and local services. However, there will be no change within 30 days of your departure.

Our prices are valid and applicable for pupils up to 16 years of age in full time education. The adult supplement is applicable for clients who are 18 years or over at the time of travel, and there maybe a small supplement for students between 16 and 18 years of age. Additional adults in excess of the numbers offered as 'free places' can normally be accepted at a supplement quoted by our office. Especially during high season it should be stressed that single, twin or double room requests must be kept to a minimum, and are strictly subject to written confirmation by the Company.

All tours are subject to surcharge as a result of circumstances referred to above. In all cases where a surcharge is applicable you will be notified up to 30 days prior to departure if a surcharge is due. We will absorb an amount equal to 2% of the tour price, excluding any insurance premium, amendment fees and changes in VAT. Only amounts in excess of 2% will be surcharged with a £1 per person administration charge. If this means paying more than 10% of the tour price you will have the option to change to another tour, if we are able to offer one, or to cancel the tour and receive a full refund of all money paid (minus insurance premiums and any amendment fees incurred). \*£50 for tours costing less than £350.

Should you wish to cancel because of this, you must exercise your right to do so within 14 days from the issue date printed on the surcharge advice. We will consider an appropriate refund of the insurance premiums paid if you can show that you are unable to transfer or reuse your policy. Should the price of your tour go down due to the changes mentioned above, by more than 2% of your tour cost, then any refund due will be paid to you. However, please note that travel arrangements are not always purchased in local currency and some apparent changes have no impact on the price of your travel due to contractual and other protection in place.

## 5. FINANCIAL PROTECTION

The Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours regulations of 1992 requires us to provide security for the monies that you pay for all holidays booked through this brochure and for your repatriation in the event of our insolvency. We provide this security by way of a bond held with ABTA (The Travel Association). Ski and Sport are members of ABTA (No Y4964). All tours by air have protection by way of a bond held by the CAA ATOL (Air Travel Protection License) No. 10526. We are obliged to maintain a high standard of service to you by ABTA's Code of Conduct. We can also offer customers an arbitration scheme for the resolution of disputes arising out of, or in connection with, this contract.. Further information on the Code and arbitration can be found at <http://www.abta.com>

**5a)** We will provide you with an ATOL Certificate which will show the size of your group together with what is included in your package. In the event of Insolvency of Ski and Sport you may be offered a similar tour by another ATOL holder. You can either chose to accept this with their relevant alterations or exceptions, or seek a full refund from the Civil Aviation Authority. Any increase of Air Passenger Duty by the CAA will be charged separately to your tour.

If you have bought a package from Ski and Sport that does not include a flight, your payments are financially protected by way of a Bond lodged with ABTA - The Travel Association, 30 Park Street London SE1 9EQ - [www.abta.co.uk](http://www.abta.co.uk). Again in the event of our insolvency you may

agree to accept an alternative package arranged by ABTA at the same cost as your original booking. In these circumstances you agree to pay any outstanding sum under the Ski and Sport contract to that alternative supplier. However you also agree that if this alternative is not available you are entitled to make a claim under ABTA's Scheme of Protection for a refund of the monies you have paid to Ski and Sport.

The Arbitration scheme is arranged by ABTA and administered independently by ADRS, part of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. It provides for a simple and inexpensive method of arbitration on documents alone with restricted liability on you in respect of costs. The scheme does not apply for claims greater than £5,000.00 per person or £25,000.00 per booking form. Neither does it apply to claims which are solely in respect of physical injury or illness or their consequences. The scheme can however deal with compensation claims which include an element of minor injury or illness subject to a limit of £1000.00 on the amount the Arbitrator can award per person in respect of this element. The application for Arbitration must be received by IDRS within 9 months of return from the holiday. Outside this time limit arbitration under the scheme may still be available if the Company agrees, but the ABTA Code does not require such agreement.

For injury and illness claims you may wish to use the ABTA/Chartered Institute of Arbitrators Mediation Procedure. This is a voluntary scheme and requires us to agree for mediation to go ahead. The aim is to help you resolve your dispute in a quick cost effective way. Again details are available from [www.abta.com](http://www.abta.com).

If you book arrangements other than a package tour (as defined by The Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992,) the financial protection referred to above does not apply.

## 6. ALTERATIONS AND CHANGES BY YOU

Should you wish to make any changes to your confirmed booking, you must notify us in writing as soon as possible. We will do all we can to make the necessary amendments, provided we have written confirmation of the change from the person who signed the booking form. Where we can meet your request we reserve the right to make an administration charge of £20 per amendment, together with any costs incurred by ourselves and any costs or charges incurred or imposed by any of our suppliers in making the change. This includes name changes.

## 7. IF WE CANCEL OR CHANGE YOUR HOLIDAY

Because arrangements shown in this brochure are made many months in advance, changes are sometimes necessary. These will usually only be minor changes that do not entitle you to compensation. Whilst we always endeavour to avoid changes and cancellations, we must reserve the right to do so. Most changes will be considered minor such as but not limited to changes to overseas airport, airline, aircraft, ferries or coaches used, changes to departure times of less than 12 hours or the withdrawal of certain facilities. These changes will be advised at the earliest possible date.

Occasionally, we have to make a significant change which includes a change of accommodation to that of a lower official classification or standard for the whole or a major part of the time you are away, a change of resort from one country to another, a change of outward departure time of more than 12 hours. In the unlikely event of this happening you will have a choice of the following options:

- Accepting the changed arrangements
- Purchasing an alternative ski tour from us, of a similar standard



# TERMS & CONDITIONS

Compensation will be paid, as outlined below, per full paying passenger, if we have to make a major change to your tour within 10 weeks of the scheduled departure date unless the change is due to circumstances beyond our control including, but not limited to, war, the threat of war, riot, civil commotion, actual or threatened terrorist activity, act of god, industrial dispute, governmental action, epidemic, disease, adverse weather or natural disaster:

More than 70 days	Nil
70-30 days	£5 per paying member
28-15 days	£10 per paying member
14 days or less	£15 per paying member

On rare occasions, especially at the beginning and end of the season, a ski area may be without snow. When we know that to be the case before departure, we may, at our absolute discretion, offer affected clients the option of transferring their ski tour and/or their accommodation to other ski areas in the same or other countries in order to make skiing possible. Snow is of course totally outside of our control and a lack of it will not constitute a significant change, compensation payments referred to above will not therefore in this case apply.

Compensation will not be payable if we are forced to cancel, or in any way change your tour for reasons of consolidation due to minimum numbers not being attained or force majeure. Operation of all tours is dependent on a minimum number of persons booking the tour. If that number is not achieved, we reserve the right to cancel the tour.

In no circumstances, except for non payment of the balance, or events beyond our control, will we cancel your tour within 10 weeks of departure.

NB. In the interests and the comfort and safety of all our customers, employees and suppliers, we reserve the right to terminate the tour arrangements of any customer whose behaviour, in our opinion, or the opinion of other persons in authority, is such that it likely to cause upset, danger or injury to our staff, customers or others or damage to property.

## 8. OUR LIABILITY TO YOU

Our contracts with hotels and carriers provide for the allocation of rooms and seats to us. Your booking will normally be made within those allocations but no specific rooms or seats can or will be confirmed. However, we accept responsibility for ensuring that all to a reasonable standard. Our obligations, and those of our suppliers providing any service or facility included in your tour, are to take reasonable skill and care to arrange for the provision of such services and facilities. You must show that reasonable skill and care has not been used, and that you have suffered loss as a result, if you wish to make any claim.

We will though not be responsible or pay you compensation for any injury, illness, death, loss, damage, expense, cost or other claim which results from:

- (a) The act(s) and/or omission(s) of the person affected;
- (b) The act(s) and/or omission(s) of a third party not connected with the provision of the services contracted for and which were unforeseeable or unavoidable; or
- (c) Force Majeure as defined or unusual or unforeseeable circumstances beyond our control, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all due care had been exercised; or
- (d) an event which either ourselves, our employees, agents or suppliers and subcontractors could not, even with all due care, have foreseen or forestalled.

In the event of (b), (c) and (d) above, we will nevertheless provide you with reasonable assistance should you require it but reserve the right to pass on any charges we incur. The services and facilities included in your tour will be deemed to be provided with reasonable skill and care if they comply with any local regulations which apply, or, if there are no applicable local regulations, if they are reasonable when compared to the local standards or customary practice of the service or facility in question. The fact that services or facilities do not comply with local or UK guidance or advice shall not mean that the services or facilities have not been provided with reasonable skill and care.

We limit the amount of compensation we may have to pay you if we are found liable under this clause as follows:

- (a) Loss of and/or damage to any luggage or personal possessions and money, Where we are found liable for loss of and/or damage to the above, the maximum amount we will have to pay you is limited to the excess amount payable under the insurance policy we offer per person affected. You are required to have taken out adequate insurance at the time of booking.
- (b) Claims not falling under (a) above or involving injury, illness or death, the maximum amount we will pay you in respect of these claims is twice the price paid by or on behalf of the person(s) affected in total. This maximum amount will only be payable where everything has gone wrong and you or your party proves you have not received any benefit at all from your booking.
- (c) Claims in respect of international travel by air, sea and rail, or any stay in a hotel.

The extent of our liability will in all cases be limited to the same extent as if we were carriers under the appropriate conventions, Directives and Regulations, which include but are not limited to The Warsaw/Montreal Convention (international travel by air); The Athens convention (with respect to sea travel); The Berne/Cotif Convention (with respect to rail travel); and The Paris Convention (with respect to hotel arrangements). You can ask for copies of these conventions from our offices or obtain them on the internet. In addition, you agree that the operating carrier or transport company's own 'Conditions of Carriage' are incorporated into this contract and will apply to you on this journey. When arranging transport for you, we rely on the terms and conditions contained within these international conventions and those 'Conditions of carriage'. You acknowledge and agree that these form a part of your contract with us, as well as with the transport company applicable.

In any circumstances in which a carrier is liable to you by virtue of the denied boarding regulation 2004, reimbursement, in such cases, is the responsibility of the airline and will not automatically entitle you to a refund of your holiday cost from us. If any payments to you are due from us, any payment to you by the airline will be deducted from this amount. When making any payment, we are entitled to deduct any money which you have received or are entitled to receive from any supplier or transport provider or hotelier for the complaint in question.

It is a pre-condition of our acceptance of liability under this clause that you notify any claim to ourselves and our suppliers strictly in accordance with the complaints procedure set out in clause 11 of these conditions failing which no payment will be made.

Where any payment is made, that the person(s) receiving it (and their parent or guardian if under 18 years) must also assign to ourselves or our insurers any rights they may have to pursue any third party and must provide ourselves and our insurers with all assistance we may reasonably require. We will not accept responsibility for services or facilities which do not form part of our contractual agreement as set out

in our confirmation invoice. For example any excursion you book, or any service or facility which your hotel or any other supplier agrees to provide to you.

## 9. PROMPT ASSISTANCE IN RESORT

If the contract we have with you is not performed or is improperly performed as a result of failures attributed to a third party unconnected with the provision of the services, or as a result of failures due to unusual and unforeseeable circumstances beyond our control, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all due care had been exercised, or an event which we or our suppliers, even with all due care, could not foresee or forestall, and you suffer an injury or other material loss, we will offer you such prompt assistance as is reasonable in the circumstances.

## 10. PASSPORT, VISAS & IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

Whilst we are able to provide basic advice to clients regarding passports and visa requirements, you should check with the appropriate Embassy, Consulate or British Foreign Office for the exact requirements of the country(ies) to or through which you are intending to travel. Requirements may change and you must check for your chosen tour and date of travel.

The party leader is entirely responsible for the completion of passport and visa formalities and other personal arrangements which may be necessary such as visa for non-British citizens. We cannot accept responsibility for any cost or fines incurred due to non-compliance with the above nor can we accept any liability if you are refused entry onto any transport or into any country due to failure on your part to carry correct documentation. ## 11. CAN SOMEONE TRAVEL IN YOUR PLACE

Only if the proper amendment procedure is followed – see clauses 3 & 6. Accommodation is reserved only for the use of the persons named on the passenger names list. Subletting, sharing or assignment is prohibited.

## 12. IF YOU HAVE A COMPLAINT

We aim to provide you with the best tour possible, but if a problem should arise, you must report it immediately, or as soon as is reasonably possible, to our local representative, our country manager or our office and to the relevant supplier of the service, so that we are given an opportunity to resolve the problem on the spot. If, after allowing our representative the opportunity to deal with the matter, you remain dissatisfied, your party leader should ask our representative for a customer services report form and record your dissatisfaction formerly in writing. Your party leader should then write to Ski and Sport, Unit 2 Willow House, 4 Stubley Hollow, Dronfield, Derbyshire S18 1PA - quoting your booking reference number, within 28 days of returning from your holiday. We will not accept liability for any complaint, not reported to our representative, if such a complaint could have been resolved had it been reported, nor for any complaint received outside the 28 day period. We always aim to resolve any complaint amicably, but if this cannot be done, you are entitled to take advantage of the Scheme of Arbitration previously described. We undertake to acknowledge receipt of your letter within 14 days and within 28 days to send you a full reply or an explanation for the delay. In any event we undertake to send you a full reply within 56 days. If you do not follow this simple complaints procedure your right to claim any compensation will be limited to £100.

## 13. TRAVEL INFORMATION ALL HOLIDAYS

Length of Tour: On all our coach holidays Ski and Sport consider day 1 as the departure day from the UK port and the final day as the arrival back into the UK. For groups who have a long journey too and from the UK port, the actual number of days involved overall may be greater than the advertised tour length because of this actual travel in the UK.

Coach Tours: All Ski and Sport tour are operated by Executive coaches. All the coaches we use are personally vetted by our staff and are all of a high standard. We only use reliable operators who in turn only use modern, comfortable coaches. All vehicles are fitted with the following features as standard:-

Seat belts (which must be used at all times - the party leader and accompanying adults are responsible for ensuring that the lap belts are worn at all times during coach travel. Please note that coaches hired locally on the continent are not yet subject to the same legislation).

Your coach will pick your party up at your designated departure point, remain with you throughout the tour and return you to this point.

Drivers Hours: All itineraries are agreed with coach companies prior to departure adhering to strict EU driving regulations. Please also note that due to driver's hours coaches may not be available to use prior to departure on the final day. Seat belts are now fitted to all coaches.

We reserve the right to utilize any empty coach seats for our clients or staff.

Timings: All timings shown in our publications are for guidance only. They are subject to confirmation and alteration. Your confirmation of travel details will be given within 4 to 6 weeks of departure and after final balances have been paid.

Delays: We would like to guarantee that all our departures would not be delayed and most do in fact depart on time. Unfortunately though, delays do occur. These are completely beyond our control but we work closely with our transport companies and overseas representatives to ensure any such delay is as short as possible. Our aim is to minimise the inconvenience of delays so far as is possible but your travel insurance offers real protection.

## 14. ACCOMMODATION AND RATINGS

Official ratings are set by the relevant authorities in each country and are mentioned in the brochure descriptions where applicable. Different countries do not have the same methods of rating hotels and holiday accommodation and, consequently, a 3 star hotel in one country may not have the same standards as a 3 star hotel somewhere else. It is also likely that there will be other guests staying in your accommodation and consequently facilities and entertainment may vary according to the mix and ages of such guests.

Rooms: Rooms are normally available from 1400 hours on arrival day and must be vacated by 10.00hrs on the day of departure. Every effort is made for the availability of washing and secure luggage storage facilities on the day of departure. On most occasions student accommodation will comprise of 2-4 beds per room, using bunk beds where appropriate, but will all have full en-suite facilities. Staff travelling with school groups will be given twin/double rooms where necessary but single rooms will carry the appropriate supplement.

Facilities: The cost of using hotel facilities eg Swimming pools, hot tubs etc are not always included. Please also note that any use of these

facilities must be supervised at all times and no swimming facilities will be available when a full qualified attendant is not on duty. All opening times of said facilities must be adhered to.

**Deposits:** Some apartments and some hotels sometimes ask for a damage deposit. This deposit is fully refundable at the end of the stay provided no damage has been caused. Please also note that most ski resorts with electronic lift passes also ask for a lift ticket deposit (approximately 5 Euros) which is also refunded on return of the lift pass to our representative at the end of the week.

**Meals:** All our school ski tours include full board with a hot midday meal unless an alternative is stated and/or requested. Adult passengers are on half board, again unless an alternative is requested. We believe that lunch is an important meal, especially for skiers, using high energy. Breakfast will be of a continental style unless stated otherwise. No drinks, other than with breakfast and water, are provided on any tour.

**Facilities:** Wi-fi and Internet services in hotels is subject to local supplier conditions over which we have no control and so cannot be responsible for non-availability or absence of service. Where accommodation is described as offering 'doorstep' skiing it will be dependent on individual skiers ability and snow conditions in resort. Where walking distances are quoted, it is based on the guideline time for an adult walking 100m in one minute in standard footwear as timings will vary on footwear and conditions including personal fitness. Free ski bus services may be subject to capacity restrictions.

## 15. SNOW GUARANTEE

Our resorts have been chosen carefully for their snow record and back-up but in the event of you not being able to ski in the resort of your choice, due to closure of all the lifts in your resort, as a result of insufficient snow, or avalanche. Ski and Sport will transport you each day, if possible, to the nearest skiable resort and provide you with a lift pass for that resort up to a maximum cost of £20 per person per day. In the event of this not being possible each paying person will be able to claim through the inclusive insurance policy, if taken, up to £20 per day for each complete day you were unable to ski. Please note that this guarantee is only applicable for tours taken between 31st December and 31st March. No other refunds will be made for prebooked services. Piste closure insurance does not apply when lifts do not operate due to mechanical failure or adverse weather conditions such as high winds or blizzards.

## 16. HOLIDAY INFORMATION, PASSPORTS AND VISAS (BRITISH CITIZENS)

A valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. If you need to apply for a passport or renew an expired one, you should do so well in advance of travel (at least 2 months before travel). In peak periods it is advisable to allow even longer. If, after booking a holiday, but before travelling, any members of your party change their name eg marriage, we must be informed immediately so that we can make the necessary changes to your documentation. Failure to advise us of such changes could result in tickets and insurance becoming invalid. Please note that both passport and visa regulations can change and therefore you should check with the necessary authorities or embassy well in advance of travel. It is your responsibility to be in possession of a valid passport and, if necessary, a visa. It can often take some time to obtain a visa so you are advised to apply in good time. It is essential that holders of non British passports check entry requirements with the consulate or embassy of the country to be visited. This is particularly important with France where all non EU nationals must apply for a visa if travelling to or through France.

**Brexit:** Please note that from 1st January 2021 British Citizens will need to apply for a Visa similar to the USA Esta) to travel to the EU. In addition all passengers should ensure that they have a run on period on their passport of no less than 6 months. This applies to all destinations. Please note that the cost for these Visas is at the passengers expense.

**Covid-19:** Please see our lead in pages for the latest situation regarding Covid 19.

## 17. AGES AND ADULTS

Prices are valid for pupils in full time education, aged 17 years and under on the day of departure. Pupils in full time education aged 18 and over may be required to pay a small supplement. In certain resorts pupils aged 13 and over may be required to pay a supplement, this will be advised to you at the time of booking. Concessions for party leader children are also based on the child being aged 17 and under on the day of departure. Accompanying adults over and above the free place ratio on a school tour will be required to pay a supplement of £60 per adult (max 5 extra adults), and the relevant adult lift pass supplement. Please note we can not guarantee rooming requests for additional adults joining a group. Ski and Sport reserve the right to re-cost the tour if more than 20% of the party are aged 19 and over.

## 18. SAFETY STANDARDS AND RISK ASSESSMENT

The safety standards and regulations overseas are those of the country in question and are not necessarily the same as those of the UK. The monitoring, enforcement and compliance with local regulations is carried out by the appropriate authorities in the country concerned. We do urge that you take all reasonable precautions to protect yourself and your group whilst on your tour. Ski and Sport also have a risk assessment available for all passengers including a detailed examination of all hotels used.

## 19. BROCHURE ACCURACY

All resorts and accommodation descriptions are carefully checked by our staff before going to print. However hoteliers and providers of services etc may withdraw a facility temporarily, or otherwise, especially at the start or end of a ski season. This is beyond our control. When we are told of any long term or significant changes we will inform you at the time of booking, or, if you have already booked we will advise you before departure if there is time. Some advertised amenities such as sports facilities may carry a charge. Both descriptions and photographs depict facilities that may not necessarily be available throughout the season. It should be remembered that adverse conditions such as high winds or too much snow may result in the closure of ski lifts, toboggan runs or other amenities.

## 20. HEALTH PRECAUTIONS

The Party leader signing the booking form is entirely responsible for passing on any health requirement information to other party members. Party leaders may wish to refer to the Department of Health leaflet T7.1. Facilities, hygiene and disease vary world-wide. You should take health advice about your specific needs as early as possible. Sources of advice include the Department of Health's free leaflet as mentioned above – "Health Advice for Travellers" available from places such as your GP, Post Office or on-line. We also recommend party leaders consult their own doctor who will be best positioned to take into account any relevant personal factors or medical requirements. We recommend that all party members travelling within the EU have a valid EHIC.

## 21. SPECIAL REQUESTS

We will do our utmost to pass on any special requests (eg cots, special meals) to the appropriate persons provided they are made known to us well in advance of travel and in writing. However we cannot guarantee that any/all special requests will be fulfilled and failure to do so does not constitute a breach of contract.

If you are disabled: Whilst we will do everything we can to provide the highest level of service to all our customers we feel that it is only right to point out that we are not a "specialist" tour operator in the field of travel for the disabled. The majority of overseas hotels and apartments are not equipped to cater for the needs of many disabled holiday makers. Furthermore the natural terrain, weather and layout of many ski resorts can make life difficult for wheelchair users. It is therefore important, if you have a disability, that the appropriate enquiries are made about the suitability of particular resorts and accommodation and that you are fully satisfied that you have made the correct choice before you book and confirm the holiday.

## 22. VAT

All tour prices with Ski and Sport are quoted inclusive of VAT. Please note that all our tours fall within the Tour Operators Margin Scheme (TOMS) for VAT purposes and therefore it is not possible to issue a VAT invoice. In all cases no VAT reclaim will be possible. Please contact us if further clarification is required.

## 23. DATA PROTECTION

None of the information you provide to Ski and Sport in connection with your booking, will be divulged to persons unconnected with your booking without your express permission. The contact details supplied, including postal address, contact numbers and email address, will only be used to fulfill tour administration and to communicate details of Ski and Sport products and services.

The personal information supplied about party members will only be used to allow our employees, agents, sub-contractors and suppliers to provide the promised service to our normal high standards.

## 24. INSURANCE

We insist that all travellers take out a comprehensive policy of insurance to cover yourself against cancellation by you; the cost of assistance (including repatriation) in the event of illness or injury; loss of baggage and money; and other expenses.

A comprehensive policy of insurance is included in our tours unless requested otherwise. We strongly advise you check it carefully to ensure that all the details are correct and that all relevant information has been provided by you (eg pre-existing medical conditions). Failure to disclose relevant information will affect your insurance. We strongly recommend that you obtain and carry a medical consent form for each member of your party under the age of 18 years.

## 25. FOREIGN & COMMONWEALTH OFFICE INFORMATION
